### Road Closures

Road closures are in place every Saturday and Sunday on Queen's Drive and these commence from 08:15. The Park roads then re-open from 17:00 in March; 18:00 April; 19:00 May; 21:00 June, July & August; 19:00 September; 18:00 in October and 15:00 (late Oct to early Mar).

The High Road is open on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays only from 09:30 – 15:00 and remains closed at weekends.

The roads in Holyrood Park are owned by the Scottish Ministers and Historic Environment Scotland has the authority to implement road closures when required or requested. The exception to this arrangement is 'the loop' road between Holyrood Gait and Horse Wynd, where the knock-on effect to bus services and traffic in the city centre, requires a stop and hold or road closure to be put in place by either The City of Edinburgh Council or a traffic management company.
