#### WHAT IS SKETCHFAB?

<u>Sketchfab</u> is an app and an online platform where you can explore 3D models, virtual reality (VR), and augmented reality (AR). Historic Environment Scotland upload models of some of our 336 properties and over 38,000 historic artefacts for you to view and explore at home from any device for free.

You can be a virtual tourist, or simply explore some of our sites that may be difficult for you to get to. View models of places like Mousa Broch in Shetland, and get up close with objects like Roman artefacts from along the Antonine Wall, sculptures, coins, and weapons.

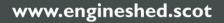
### WHAT IS DIGITAL DOCUMENTATION AND INNOVATION?
