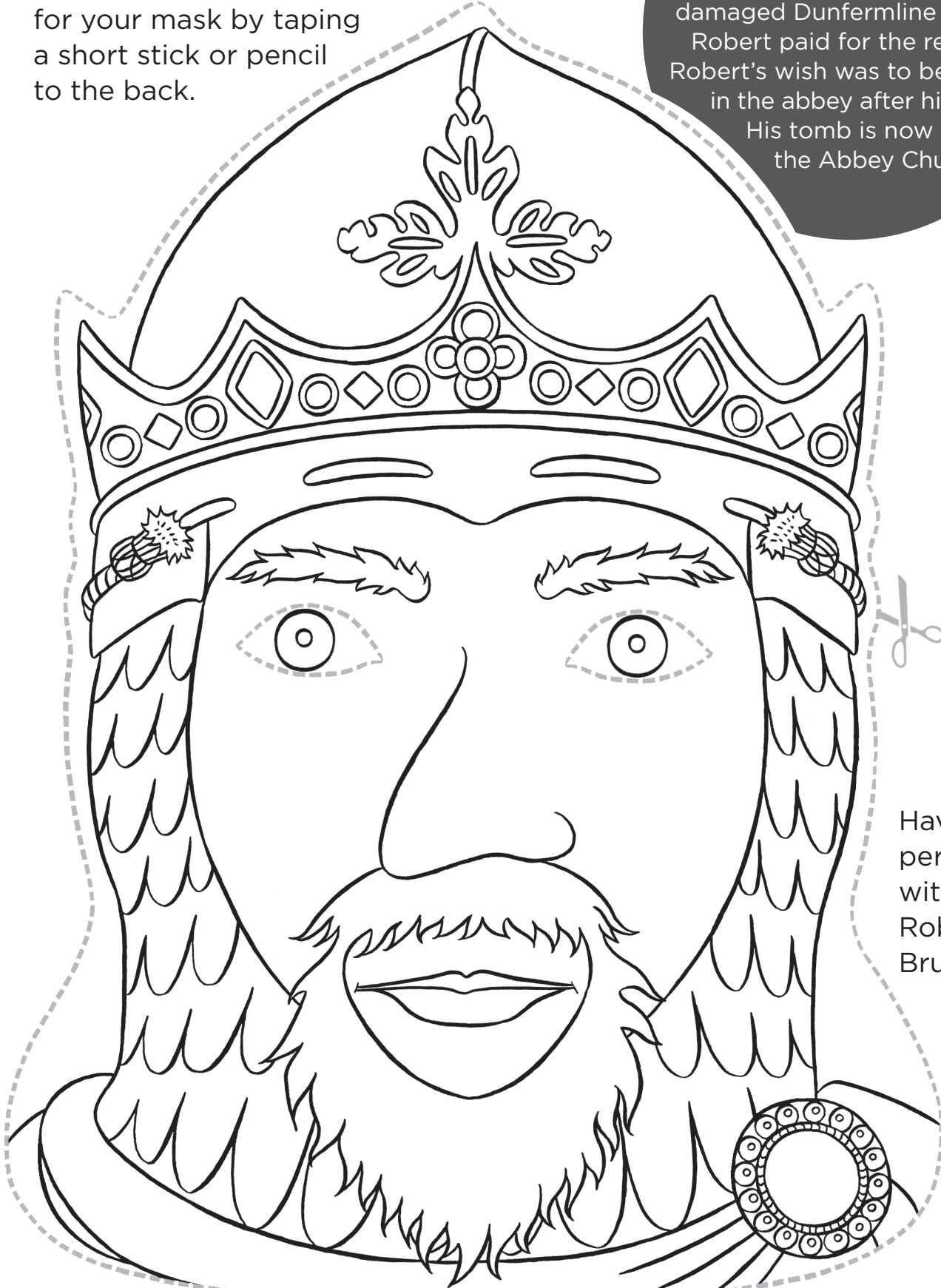
Make your own mask

Robert the Bruce was king
of Scotland from 1303-1329.
When Edward I of England's army
damaged Dunfermline Abbey,
Robert paid for the repairs.
Robert's wish was to be buried
in the abbey after his death.
His tomb is now in
the Abbey Church.
