# HERITAGE & PLACE PROGRAMME

## BACKGROUND


- Successor to the Conservation Area Regeneration Scheme (CARS)
- 2-stage application process
- Open to Local authorities, national park authorities and qualifying not for profit organisations
- Schemes will need to be within a defined area of the historic environment and include a range of projects and activities



# HERITAGE & PLACE PROGRAMME

## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

- Allows us to determine whether a project will be eligible
- We can provide clear and consistent feedback and advice to applicants

- Local Authority Area
- Is it in a Conservation Area?
- Map of Scheme Area
- Any other supporting documents

## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

### The Scheme

- Why is your scheme area a priority?
- Tell us about what consultation has taken place
- Outline your projects and activities



# HERITAGE & PLACE PROGRAMME

## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

### Scheme Title

- Short
- Descriptive/ Strategic
- Can be changed at different application stages



# HERITAGE & PLACE PROGRAMME

## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

### Scheme Delivery

- Who will deliver the scheme?
- Dates of when the development and delivery phases will take place (estimated)?
- How much will each phase cost (estimated)?
- How much HES funding is being requested (estimated)?



# HERITAGE & PLACE PROGRAMME

## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

### Supporting Documents

- Map of Scheme Area (required for all applicants)
- Other documents can be uploaded in support of your EOI although these are not a requirement e.g.:
  - Governance documents and accounts (if a not-for-profit org)
  - Joint Delivery Agreement (if applicable)
  - Images of scheme area/ projects
  - Area Character Appraisal/ Area Management Plan
  - Other e.g.; Letters of support; local planning or strategic documents to support your proposal

# HERITAGE & PLACE PROGRAMME

## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

### Decisions and Next Steps

- Decisions within 6 weeks from EOI deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> July
- We will advise ineligible schemes as soon as possible after submission
- Invited to submit Development Phase Application by Mid-December

# HERITAGE & PLACE PROGRAMME

## DEVELOPMENT PHASE APPLICATION

### **Development Phase:**

Similar questions to EOI but with added level of detail requested in relation to:

- Scheme Area
- How and when the development and delivery phases will be delivered
- The proposed projects and activities included in the delivery phase under each of the 4 themes

# HERITAGE & PLACE PROGRAMME

## DEVELOPMENT PHASE APPLICATION

### **Development Phase:**

In addition:

- Development Phase Activities
- General condition of properties and supporting evidence of this
- Availability of local heritage skills and any associated risks
- Wider social, economic or environmental issues in the scheme area and supporting evidence of this.
- Outcomes in relation to HES Grants Priorities

### Supporting Documents:

- Governing Document, Accounts And Draft Cash-flow (NFP Organisations)
- Joint Delivery Agreement (Outline)
- Local, Regional And National Strategies
- Letters Of Support
- Area Partnership Agreement (Outline)
- Cost Breakdown And In-kind Cost Calculations If Applicable
- Job Descriptions And Consultant Brief
- Map And Images Of Scheme Area And Projects
- Scheme Timetable
- Area Character Appraisal (Draft)


## APPLICATION PROCESS

		Deadline	Decision timeframe
1	Expression of Interest	31 July 2022	As soon as possible (no later than 6 weeks after EOI deadline)
2	Development Phase application	15 <sup>th</sup> December 2022	Decision within 3-4 months
3	Development Phase	Up to 12 months	N/A
4	Delivery Phase application	Within 12 months of date of Development Award	Decision within 3-4 months
